PORTAL AUTHORITY ISSUES WARNING! PLANE MERGER IMMINENT!

The Portal Authority is issuing a Magesta-wide warning urging people to stay away from the shoreline and large bodies of water from now until the beginning of Enlightening. Information collected by agent Margaret Penn of the Irvanshirian chapter of the Portal Authority has suggested that a merger between the Astral Plane of Magesta and that of a dimension known as Ahn' Tumbel (which is currently in its own Astral Plane) is in effect and should be completed within the next moon or so. The Portal Authority is now able to confirm this suggestion. Though such mergers are not normally very dangerous. it is postulated that this merger may neither be naturally occurring nor balanced and. as such. could pose a significant threat to Magestans the world over.

Agent Penn. based on the research she has done. suggests that the elemental planes of Water and Earth might. potentially, offer the biggest threats to Magesta as they merge, due to the absence. destruction. or creation of several "bridges" between said planes. Though this theory cannot be confirmed in its entirety, there is recent evidence of strong surges of energy pulsing outward from the elemental plane of Water, and as such precautions must be taken.

The Portal Authority would like to remind people to stay calm. but to avoid or use caution around large bodies of water. especially around the shorelines.

Huge tidal waves, floods, and surges are expected within the next few weeks, but it is generally accepted that the merger will be completed sometime during the last week of Petalsong, after which things should return to normal.





MAGE8TRY'8 Next Event is May 4th-6th, 2012

At Chesterfield Scout Reservation in Chesterfield, MA

The fee for the next event is \$60 for PCs (\$55 if *received* by Apr. 27th) and Free for NPCs. <u>Cabin space is limited.</u> When you pre-register (this includes payment) choose your cabin *preference*. Directions to Chesterfield Scout Reservation Sugar Hill Road Chesterfield, Massachusetts:

From the South: Take I-91 North to Exit 19 in Massachusetts. Stay straight on the Route 9 Truck Route (Damon Road becoming Bridge Road) for 3.3 miles before taking a right onto Route 9 West. Stay on 9 West for 5 miles, going into Williamsburg, and then turn left onto Route 143. In 4.1 miles, the camp road will be on your right. Drive up that road and park in the large dirt lot that will come shortly up on your right (after the Camp Office driveway).
